When Do We Reassess?

All students starting at Oxford Learning receive a Dynamic Assessment before they start classes. The results show essential literacy levels, auditory and visual discrimination, and cognition.

Why? We do this because we want every student to receive the best possible instruction that we can give. The results yield a plan for how best to teach to the individual's needs.

Did you know that it takes almost a year of training and practice to receive certification as an assessor? It takes time to learn how to evaluate strengths and weaknesses.

Did you know that even though we charge for assessments, they actually save you money? We get to the root of learning issues without wasting time, and in a way that meets the student's needs.

Is reassessment needed? Yes and no. We only do a Dynamic Assessment one time. We need to do a complete academic assessment every so often to measure their improvement properly. We do this on a scheduled class time as part of our regular course of business (after 6 or 12 months of enrolment).
